
Einstein

Who is the most famous scientist of all time? Who is the greatest genius? For many people, the answer is the physicist, Albert Einstein.

Einstein wasn't a child prodigy. When he was a baby, he was slow to talk. When he was nine years old, he couldn't speak well. Einstein left school when he was only fifteen. He didn't like the classes. He preferred to study at home with books about mathematics, physics and philosophy. When he was seventeen, Einstein wanted to study at the Institute of Technology in Zurich, Switzerland, but he didn't pass the entrance examination. Einstein wasn't a good student, but his ideas changed the way we look at the world. In 1921, he won the Nobel Prize.

When he died, a doctor removed his brain to discover the secrets of his intelligence. Albert

Einstein's brain was smaller than normal because he was a small person. In 1999, scientists in Canada discovered that the part of Einstein's brain responsible for mathematical calculations 15% bigger than normal. In the same year Time magazine named him 'person of the century'.
